Open Water Swimming Series Coming to Mullaloo Beach

On Saturday 30th December 2017, the Swimming WA Open Water Swimming Series is coming to Mullaloo Beach for the last swim of 2017.

Round 5 of the series has something for everyone with distances ranging from : 500m, 1.25km, 2.5km, 5km and 10km.

Thanks to the support of City of Joondalup, this family friendly will start from 7:30am and is expecting to attract 700 swimmers.

The OWS Series kicked off at Cottesloe Beach on 4th November 2017 with a record 740 swimmers taking part. Since then it has visited Bunbury, Coogee and Leighton, and the State Open Water Swimming championships were held last month at Champion Lakes. A new event called the Relay Round has been added to the series and is taking place at Scarborough Beach tomorrow.

Celebrating 10 years, the SWA OWS Series runs throughout the summer until March 2018 and attracts 6,000 competitive and novice swimmers.
